

Troops destroy hoodlums' camps in Imo, exhume three bodies of victims

TROOPS of 34 Artillery Brigade, Obinze, Imo State, on Saturday, operated at Awo-Omama and Ezioha communities in Mbaitoi Local Government Area

of Imo State, where they destroyed hoodlums' camps.

The troops, led by the Commander of the Brigade, Brigadier-General Usman Lawal, also exhumed three human bodies, as well as an animal suspected to have been used for rituals.

Speaking with newsmen at the

scene, Brigadier-General Lawal said one Monday, a.k.a. B44 and members of his gang had been kidnapping and killing innocent residents of the area.

He said most times, the hoodlums kill their victims even when ransom had been paid to them.

The brigade commander

said: "We are going to make sure that Imo State and South East Nigeria are free from hoodlums and that terrorism will be a thing of the past."

He called on the people to avail relevant security agencies of useful information that could help dislodge terrorists from the state.
