Two killed in Ogun cult clashes

EIYE and Aiye confraternity members clashed in different parts of Abeokuta, the Ogun State capital, leading to the death of two persons.

The clashes came barely three weeks after a member of Aiye confraternity, identified as Olumide Ifeoluwa, was shot dead by suspected members of Eiye group.

It was gathered that Sunday's clash was a reprisal for the killing of Ifeoluwa.

The first victim, said to be a member of Eiye, was killed at Alogi in Obantoko area, while the second victim, identified as Timo, reported to be a member of Aiye, was shot dead at Bode-Olude, both in Odeda Local Government Area of the state.

It was further gathered that after Timo was shot, his head was also smashed with a stone.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Omolola Odutola, when contacted, said she was yet to be briefed on the clash.
