Gunmen kill Aiyedatiwa's campaign coordinator

A ward coordinator of the All Progressives Congress (APC) in Akoko South-West Local Government Area of Ondo State, Mr Alaba Abe Excel, was, on Saturday, shot dead by gunmen who invaded his Supare Akoko home.

Excel was said to be at home with his family when the assailants arrived and killed him in the presence of his wife and children.

The State Information Director of Lucky Aiyedatiwa Campaign Organisation Foot Soldiers Independent Council (LACO-FSIC), Kayode Fasua, who confirmed the killing, said the details were, however, still sketchy.

Fasua said the group would visit the home of the late Re-

turning Officer for the party in the just concluded primary of the party in the council area to find out more about what actually happened.

Fasua, in a statement, lamented the murder of Excel, just as he appealed to the police to bring the perpetrators to justice.

He stated that the late Excel was a resourceful coordinator, campaigning for the election of Governor Lucky Aiyedatiwa until he was murdered.

Meanwhile, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Funmi Odunlami, confirmed the incident.

She said: "The command is aware of the incident at Supare Akoko; investigation is ongoing to unravel all that happened."
