4 dead in auto crash on Enugu-Onitsha Expressway

THE Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) says no fewer than four persons lost their lives in a ghastly auto accident on Ugwu Onyeama axis of the Enugu-Onitsha Federal Highway, News Agency of Nigeria

(NAN) reported.

The Sector Commander of the FRSC Enugu State Command, Mr Adevemi Sokunbi, confirmed the incident to the NAN on Wednesday in Enugu. Sokunbi said that the accident happened between 6:45 pm and 7 pm on June 11 when a trailer laden with kerosene others died at the hospital. lost control and rammed into six other vehicles...

He said that two persons died instantly among the

29 persons involved in the ghastly accident while two

Sokunbi said that the FRSC used the corps' Intensive Care Unit (ICU) ambulance and other vehicles to rush the 10 persons, who were injured to the National Orthopaedic Hospital, Enugu.

He also said that the deceased were taken to the Enugu State University Teaching Hospital (ESUT) Park Lane,

Enugu where they were deposited at the morgue.

The commander said that some items belonging to the victims were also recovered at the scene of the accident.
