Two die in Eid-el Kabir day accident in Ogun

TWO persons, on Sunday, died, while three sustained injuries in an Eid-el Kabir day accident in Ososa, on the Sagamu-Ijebu Ode Expressway in Ogun State.

According to the News
Agency of Nigeria (NAN),
spokesperson for the Federal Road Safety Corps
(FRSC) in Ogun State, Mrs
Florence Okpe, confirmed
the incident in a statement
made available to newsmen in Abeokuta.

Okpe said the accident, which occurred at

11:28a.m., involved an ashcoloured Howo truck and a blue Toyota Camry car.

She stated that the accident was caused by excessive speed which led to loss of control and subsequent collision of the two vehicles.

The FRSC spokesperson said five persons — a man and four women — were involved in the accident.

"A total of two persons were killed, which comprised one man and a woman, while three women were injured," she said.
