

Cable thief electrocuted inside FAAN powerhouse at Lagos airport

A middle-aged man who attempted to steal electrical cables and other equipment inside the powerhouse of the Federal Airports Authority of Nigeria (FAAN) at the Murtala Muhammed Airport, Lagos has been electrocuted.

The man, whose identity could not be ascertained, was reported to have found his way inside the power generating house and had begun disconnecting the installations that supplies power to the airport

before he met his Waterloo.

Confirming the incident, the Managing Director of FAAN, Mrs Olubunmi Kuku, on Monday, said FAAN will leave no stone unturned in ensuring that all loopholes that allow unauthorised persons into airports are blocked.
