Police give details of how man clubbed his 78-year-old grandpa to death in Osun

THE Osun State Police Command provided information, on Saturday about the case of a 26-year-old man, Kusibe Adedoyin, who was remanded in prison after allegedly clubbing his 78-year-old grandfather, Pa Akanbi Adedoyin, to death in llare-ijesha, located in the Obokun Local Government Area of the state.

The Public Relations Officer of the state police command, Mrs Yemisi Opalola, stated in a press release in Osogbo, the state capital, that a man allegedly committed the act at his grandfather's residence last

Monday.

She stated that Kusibe hit the grandfather on the head with a club after a disagreement between them over ownership of farmland.

According to Opalola, following a report lodged in connection with the incident, the man was arrested by the police and later charged to court and remanded in prison.

Also, commenting on the incident via a statement in Osogbo, the spokesperson of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSCDC), Mrs. Kehinde Adeleke, said, "It was gathered that Kusibe Adedoyin is a suspected drug addict."
