Two killed in Lagos-Ibadan expressway accident

THE Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) has confirmed the death of two persons in an accident on the long bridge on the Lagos-Ibadan expressway on Monday.

According to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN), spokesperson for the FRSC in Ogun state, Mrs Florence Okpe, who confirmed the incident in a statement issued in Abeokuta on Monday, said one person sustained injury in the accident.

Okpe explained that the accident occurred at 5:38a.m, and was caused by road obstruction and fa-

tigue.

The FRSC spokesperson said the accident involved a Mazda bus and a MAN diesel truck.

"The injured victim was taken to Hopeland Hospital, Warewa, while the remains of the deceased were deposited at the morgue of Real Divine Hospital, Ibafo," she said.

Okpe said the Sector Commander, Akinwumi Fasakin, advised motorists to always be on alert while driving.

He also called on motorists to always have some rest to avoid fatigue while behind the wheel.
