

Boko Haram kills four farmers in Borno

TERRORISTS suspected to be Boko Haram members have killed four farmers in Kirawa, a border town in Gwoza Local Government Area of Borno State.

The incident occurred on Thursday evening when the farmers were attacked on their farmlands.

Bukar Aji, Councillor of Kirawa Jimini Ward and Speaker of Gwoza Local Government Council, described the incident as "a sad day" and called on security agen-

cies to protect the people.

"This is a devastating blow to our community. We urge security agencies to take immediate action to ensure the safety of our people," Aji said.

Yakubu Ali, Chairman of Kirawa Development Association, condemned the attack

as "barbaric" and urged the government to take decisive action to end insurgency in the state.

"The government must do more to protect our communities from these terrorists. We cannot continue to live in fear of attacks every day," Ali said.
