Four burnt to death, 20 injured in Osun multiple accidents

O fewer than four were and 20 were iniured in a multiple fatal motor accident that involved four vehicles along

Osun/Ondo road in Ikeji-Ara- burst into flames. keii of Ori-Ade Local Government Area of Osun State.

Investigations revealed that the accident occurred three days ago when two buses and one truck had a head-on collision, resulting in causing the vehicles to

The development reportedly resulted in the burning of some passengers in the two buses, while others sustained various degrees of injuries.

The incident, which reportedly caused a traffic jam

around the scene, threw sympathizers into mourning and weeping.

However, among the passengers involved in the accident were two corps members.

Speaking about the incident, the Osun State

Commandant of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), Taofeek Sokunbi, attributed the accident to speeding and reckless driv-

According to him, "The accident occurred three days ago. Four people died, and

20 people were injured. The accident happened because the speed breaker was ignored."

Sokunbi stressed the importance of driving carefully to prevent accidents caused by speeding and carelessness.
