## Man lands in Lagos police net for allegedly pushing his younger brother to death

THE Lagos State Police Command on Saturday said it arrested and detained a man for allegedly pushing his 47-year-old younger brother to death.

The command's spokesperson, Benjamin Hundeyin, confirmed this to the News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) on Saturday.

Hundeyin said that the case was reported to the police on August 24 at about

6.40 a.m. by a resident whose name was not mentioned.

He said the resident reported that on August 23, at about 11.00 p.m., one Ayodeji Busari of Iba area in Lagos allegedly pushed his younger brother, whose name was not also mentioned.

Hundeyin added that the younger brother was said to have come from Port Har-

court, Rivers State, to visit his friend at an address not mentioned in Lagos.

Hundeyin said that the suspect allegedly pushed his younger brother down and he hit his head on the pavement during a fight.

"The victim became unconscious and was rushed to Igando General Hospital for treatment, but was later confirmed dead by the doctor on duty.

"The detectives visited the scene of the incident and took photographs, the corpse was removed and deposited at Mainland General Hospital Mortuary, Yaba, for autopsy.

"The case file and suspect will be transferred to the State Criminal Investigation Department Panti-Yaba for investigation," he said.
