

Man kills neighbour, son over sanitation in Lagos

A resident of Lagos State, Vincent (surname withheld), has been arrested by the police in the state for allegedly killing one of his neighbours and her son.

It was gathered that the deceased woman, simply identified as Gloria, and the suspect, were neighbours at Elemoro area of the state.

Nigerian Tribune gath-

ered that after the incident, the suspect was arrested by police detectives from Elemoro police station.

The deceased woman and the suspect reportedly had an argument on sanitation of the house and the argument resulted in a serious fight between them.

The state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Benjamin Hundeyin, confirmed the incident, as well as the arrest of the suspect to the Nigerian Tribune.

Hundeyin also stated that the corpses of the deceased woman and her son had been deposited at the Epe General Hospital.

The Lagos police imagemaker said: "On September 15, at about 10:50p.m. an information was received at the Elemoro division that one Vincent (surname withheld), killed one Gloria, his neighbour and her son, following an argument on cleaning.

"He [Vincent] went further to put their dead bodies on a big bag; immediately detectives of the division got the information, they rushed to the scene, arrested the suspect and recovered the corpses.

"The corpses have been deposited at the Epe General Hospital mortuary for preservation."
