How gunmen killed 37-year-old PoS operator in presence of wife, three children in Ibadan

FACTS have emerged on how gunmen killed a 35-year-old Point of Sales (PoS) operator, Bamidele Najeem Saka, in the presence of his wife and three children in Ibadan, the Oyo State capital.

Nigerian Tribune gathered that Bamidele was shot dead at 10:30p.m. at Enta Quarters, Zone 2, Liberty Academy, in Ido Local Government Area.

A security source who confirmed the incident stated that the deceased was trailed to his house by the gunmen who operated on motorcycle.

The source added: "Bamidele (37), a PoS operator,
was trailed to his residence at
Bota Quarters, Zone 2, Liberty
Academy area on the fateful
day by the gunmen.

on a motorcycle, otherwise known as okada.

The deceased was dispossessed of two bags but it could not be ascertained the exact amount that the hood-

lums went away with.

"However, after dispossessing him of his valuables, he was subsequently shot on his forehead in the presence of his wife and three children. He died on the spot."

Our source added that the case was reported at the Area Command, Orita Challenge, Ibadan.

It was gathered that the policemen, who were sent on a rescue mission, met the deceased in a pool of his own blood.

His remains, as further gathered, were deposited at the mortuary for further investigation.

The source, however, said the corpse was later released to the family as requested for burial in accordance with the Islamic rites.

When contacted, the Area Commander at the Orita Challenge, Marvis Jaiyeola, referred our correspondent to the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Adewale Osifeso, for confirmation.
