

Adamawa assembly condemns alleged killing of two men by security personnel in Mubi

ADAMAWA State House of Assembly on Tuesday, condemned the killing of two young men by security personnel operating in Mubi South Local Government Area of the state.

The security personnel, who are members of the Nigeria Army and the Nigeria Customs Service (NCS) operating in Mubi South Local Government Area were said to have shot and killed two young men who were on separate motorcycles at Nasarawo ward about two days ago.

Members of the assembly at a resumed sitting on Tuesday condemned the murder of the young men by security men who are supposed to protect them.

This followed a motion moved by the member representing Mubi South constituency in the assembly, Honourable Yohanna Sahabo Jauro,

The assembly in its reso-

lutions adopted during the sitting, advised the affected security agencies to carry out their activities with professionalism.

It urged the security agencies to address multiple checkpoints within Mubi and also directed its Committee on Security to liaise with the federal lawmakers to proffer lasting solution to the problem.

Earlier, Honourable Yohanna, while moving the motion, had informed his colleagues that some military men and customs officers shot and killed two of his constituents two days ago without any justification.

All the member present at the Tuesday' sitting condemned the action and called for urgent steps to address the trend.

After unanimous adoptions, the speaker, Honourable Bathiya Wesley, directed the clerk of the assembly to communicate the resolutions to the authorities concern.
