

# Police give details of how 19-year-old killed his child three days after girlfriend gave birth to him

THE Adamawa State Police Command on Saturday gave details of how a 19-year-old teenager, Aliyu Yaro, allegedly killed his baby boy three days after his girlfriend gave birth to him.

Spokesman of the command, SP Suleiman Nguroje, disclosed this in a statement in Yola, the state capital, on Saturday, saying

## 15 die, 13 injured in Katsina auto crash

FIFTEEN persons have been confirmed dead in a road crash on Funtua-Gusau road, in Funtua, Katsina State, by the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC).

The FRSC Sector Commander, Mr Aliyu Ma'aji, confirmed the accident in a statement by the command's Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Mr Shamsu-

the incident took place in Mubi town.

He said that operatives of the command arrested the teenager on Friday over alleged murder of the three-day-old baby.

Nguroje said the mother of the baby, whose name was given as Safiya and who is the suspect's girlfriend, reported the matter to the police.

According to the statement: "The complainant accused the suspect of murder of the three-day-old baby after she gave birth."

Nguroje said preliminary investigations showed that the suspect impregnated the lady, and after giving birth, she called him to come for his baby.

He said the suspect visited the girlfriend's house during the night and carried the baby after he sent her on an errand.

The spokesman said the suspect allegedly killed the baby and buried the corpse in the Girpata area of Mubi.

The command added: "The suspect, during interrogation, confessed to the heinous crime and took the police to where the remains were buried.

"He narrated that he impregnated the mother of the deceased who happens to be his girlfriend and after delivery, she kept calling him to come and carry the baby. He said that he went to the house of his girlfriend in the night after calling

him, carried the baby and left after he had sent her to fetch water for him."

According to him, the Commissioner of Police, Morris Dankombo has ordered the case to be transferred to the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) for more investigation.
