## Victim of police killing not KWASU student — Management

THE management of Kwara State University (KWASU), Malete has refuted reports claiming the victim of a killing at Tanke community in Ilorin was a student of the institution.

It is recalled that the state police command arrested three police officers in connection with the death of a university student, 27-yearold Suleiman Olayinka, in Ilorin.

The command's Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Adetoun Ejire-Adeyemi, had said that a complaint of cheating and criminal breach of trust was filed against Olayinka, prompting an investigation by detectives.

The statement confirmed that the officers involved in the incident had been identified, detained and are under investigation to determine their roles in Olayinka's death.

Meanwhile, in a statement, the acting director, University Relations Officer of KWASU, Dr Saeedat Aliyu, said records in the university showed that Aiyeyemi Sulaimon Olayinka had voluntarily withdrawn from the Department of Statistics of the institution since the 2018/2019 session when he was in 200 level.

"The management of the Kwara State University strongly sympathises with the family of the deceased and pray that God gives the family the fortitude to bear the loss," the statement said.
