Former college registrar found dead at home in Plateau

eral College of Education, Pankshin, now University of Education, Plateau State, has been found dead in his home with stab wounds by some relatives who heard his cry of agony.

According to information obtained by the Nigerian Tribune, the man who recently retired from the college was at home at around 10:00 am. in the morning last Wednesday in Pankshin town when some attackers broke in and stabbed him multiple times before they

ran away.

According to a family member, the man was discovered in a pool of blood after a visiting brother entered the residence and discovered him struggling to breathe and in excruciating pain.

He claimed that the victim passed away before could transport him to the hospital and that the alert brought the matter to the notice of the nearby residents.

It was gathered that the manner in which he was

killed shocked and surprised the neighbourhood; they were unable to explain how the attackers got into the house and committed the heinous act without anyone else seeing.

According to a community member who craved anonymity, the deceased was seen around his house at about 9:00 a.m on the day of his murder and pondered how someone could have entered the house covertly and murdered him without anybody seeing or leaving any evidence.

It was also discovered that on the fateful day when the tragic event took place, the deceased's wife and other household members were not present.

Nigerian Tribune further learnt that the man was buried on Monday in his village at Panyam community in Mangu Local Government Area of Plateau State amidst tears by the relatives and loved ones who witnessed the burial.

When contacted, the State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Alfred Alabo, simply declared, "The man was found in a pool of blood; the investigation is ongoing."
