

Gospel singer allegedly beheads girlfriend in Nasarawa

A gospel singer and fitness enthusiast, Oluwatimileyin Ajayi, popularly known as Timileyin, has been arrested after he was caught with the severed head of his girlfriend inside a plastic bag on Sunday. It was gathered that Ajayi,

who prides himself as multi-talented gospel singer, prolific songwriter, vocalist, recording and performing artiste, was apprehended on Sunday, January 12, near a church in Orozo area of Nasarawa State.

In a video monitored online, a police officer in plain cloth asked him how long he had been dating the lady and

he said, "Like a year."

An eyewitness explained that the suspect was asked why he had knife cuts on his hand and he said he collected the lady's phone and saw she was chatting with another guy and they started dragging the phone and she used a knife to cut his hand, which led to the injury.

He said he then collected

the knife and stabbed her in the neck and beheaded her.

The source said when the severed head was discovered with the suspect, motorcycle operators started attacking him, but the church officials tried to prevent jungle justice from being meted on him.

The source added that when he was asked where he was taking the head, "he said

one woman told him to bring the head for her.

"The police later came and took him away in their van. They also took the head," the eyewitness added.

When the Nigerian Tribune contacted the Nasarawa State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Nansel Ramhan, he said: "I don't know if he is a gospel singer, but all I can

tell you is that one Timileyin Ajayi was almost lynched by a mob for being in possession of a human head.

"Operatives went to his house and found the carcass of a lady believed to be a corps member. "The suspect has been taken to the hospital for treatment, after which he will be interrogated."
