

③ Ogun auto technicians protest killing of three members by reckless truck drivers

HUNDREDS of members of the Nigeria Automobile Technicians Association (NATA), in the Ajebo area of Ogun State, on Thursday, protested the killing of three of its members due to truck drivers' recklessness on the OGTV/Ajebo road.

It was gathered that the three lost their lives on Wednesday evening, around the Ajebo area in Abeokuta, the state capital.

The protesters expressed sadness over what it described as avoidable incident on the highway, vowing that no truck would be allowed to ply the road until a lasting solution is found.

The chairman of NATA, Ajebo Mechanic Village unit, Comrade Saheed Arulogun, told newsmen that about five persons died between December and early this month due to the reckless driving of truck drivers on the road.

Arulogun said: "We are out today to express our sadness and frustration over these truck drivers that have continued to cause avoidable loss of lives on this Ajebo/OGTV road, with the hope that something will be done by the relevant agencies."
