

Assailants kill new Ondo Poly student

A first-year Mass Communication student of Rufus Giwa Polytechnic, Owo, in Owo Local Government Area of Ondo State, identified as Oluwaseun Adeleye, was on Monday hacked to death.

The new student was killed at Opomulero area of Owo by unknown assailants, less than a month after securing admission into the school.

A student source said the remains of the late student, who was also a musician and the course representative of his class, was discovered on Monday.

The source said the Adeleye was hacked to death with a machete by the assailants and the reason behind his killing was unknown.

He added, "He [Adeleye] was a fresher who had spent just three or four weeks on campus. In fact, he was a course representative. It is sad that we lost him. Unfortunately, he was macheted."

The Public Relations Officer of the institution, Samuel Ojo, who confirmed the incident, said, "It was just unfortunate."

The state Police Public Relations Officer, (PPRO) Funmi Odunlami, also confirmed the incident to newsmen.

She said: "Yes, it's a case of suspected murder of one Seun Ojo Adeleye, an ND 1 student of Mass Communication; police have begun investigation into the incident."
