MACBAN chairman killed in Plateau

THE chairman of the Myetti
Allah Cattle Breeders Association (MACBAN), Barakin-Ladi
Local Government Area of
Plateau State, Mallam Mohammadu Adamu, was on
Wednesday, killed by gunmen.

The state chairman of MAC-BAN, Ibrahim Yusuf Babayo,

who confirmed the killing, stated that shortly after the deceased broke his fast with friends and family, the gunmen forced their ways into his house at about 8;00p.m. and opened fire on him at close range.

"Immediately they shot him, the gunmen escaped from the scene, while neighbours tried to save his life. He

was later pronounced dead at the Barakin-Ladi General Hospital."

Babayo, therefore, called on security agencies to carry out thorough investigation into the incident with the aim of bringing the perpetrators to book.

A youth in the community, Alhaji Danjuma Ibrahim, who also spoke on the incident,

said the remains of the deceased were buried on Thursday in the council area.

He pointed out that the lastest attack on Adamu's life was the third in recent times, just as he called on security agencies to fish out those responsible for the murder.

Ibrahim said: "The gunmen shot him several times before they fled the area."
