

3 Kwara community kills criminals after vigilante member was shot dead

PEOPLE of Eleyin community in the Isin Local Government Area of Kwara State have killed some criminals who have been terrorising the area in recent times.

Sunday Tribune gathered that a member of the vigilante group in the community, Mr Saheed Adeshina, lost his life while resisting the attack by the hoodlums.

While the specific number of criminals killed by the community could not be confirmed as of the time of this report, it was gathered that the vigilante group lost some of their motorcycles.

Meanwhile, members of the Eleyin community staged a peaceful protest on Saturday, blocking the Ilorin–OmuAran road at Oke-Onigbin town, over incessant kidnapping in the area. Many motorists caught up in the protest lamented the development.

The Kwara State governor, Mallam Abdulrahman Abdulrazaq, in a statement by his Chief Press Secretary (CPS), Rafiu Ajakaye, commended the bravery of the local vigilance team, urging continuous firm action against criminals.

The governor, who mourned the death of the vigilante member, approved N10 million support for the family of the slain vigilante, while he appealed for calm.
