## Thunder strikes man dead in Ado Ekiti

There was panic in the Basiri area of Ado-Ekiti Local Government last week when a man was struck dead by thunder following a torrential rains and thunderstorms.

National Mirror gathered that the victim, a <u>bricklay</u>er identified simply as as Kunle, was said to be working at a building site on Ilamodi Street when he was struck dead by thunder. Immediately, shops and other businesses were closed as traditional worshippers were said to have declared curfew on movements to enable them perform rituals and cleansing of the community.

The Ekiti State police command, confirmed receiving a report of the incident, and explained that "it was a sudden and unnatural death." The commandPublic Relations Officer, Mohammed Jimoh said that "it is the family that will remove the body on their own"
