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Killing: IGP asked to weed out bad eggs from Force

•Driver dead, two injured in Ekiti auto crash

Inspector-General of Police (IGP) Mohammed Abubakar, has been urged to weed out bad eggs from the Nigerian Police Force.

A Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) governorship aspirant in Ekiti State, Dr Peter Obafemi, said the manner in which the police at Oye Ekiti killed a student of Ekiti State University (EKSU), Mr Seyi Fasere, a fortnight ago showed that bad eggs were still in the Force.

In a statement made available yesterday in Ado- Ekiti yesterday, Obafemi, said: "The authorities must ensure that the bad ones are weeded out of the police to stop corrupting the good ones."

He queried the whereabouts of the N100,000 school fees that the late student's family gave him at his lupeju-Ekiti residence before he was killed.

Asking the Ekiti State Commissioner of Police, Mr Sotonye Wakama, to ensure that the policeman accused of killing Seyi is arrested for prosecution, Obafemi said: "The killing of Mr Seyi Fasere, a 400 level student of Business Administration and Management of EKSU, Ado Ekiti, is another in the long list of extra judicial killing in this country.

"The boy was arrested after a gang of robbers raided a bank in Oye-Ekiti and killed the following day at a police station. This is summary execution and should not be allowed to continue.

"Seyi's killing has brought sorrow on his parents, siblings and relations, who toiled to educate him.

"Nigerians want to know how this boy was killed. The Inspector-General of Police must ensure



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that the case is not swept under the carpet. A particular photograph of Seyi's body his family said they took at the police station showed that his two hands were tied to the back".

Meanwhile, a driver died yesterday in a lone accident involving a truck laden with earth-moving equipment at Aramoko-Ekiti in the Ekiti West Council area of Ekiti State.

The two other occupants of the truck, who were injured in the crash, were rushed to the General Hospital in Aramoko-Ekiti.

The trailer attached to the truck detached while the vehicle was descending a steep portion of the Aramoko – Ado Ekiti Road, thus forcing the truck to somersault severally just as the bulldozer fell off the trailer.

The driver, who was said to have flung out of the vehicle in the process, was unfortunate as his skull was shattered by the tyres of his vehicle.

Eyewitnesses said the driver had negotiated the bend on slope with high speed, thus causing a tilt in the bulldozer on the trailer which eventually compelled the trailer to detach from the truck belonging to Seeignal Construction Company.

The police spokesman, Mr Victor Babayemi Olu confirmed the accident.

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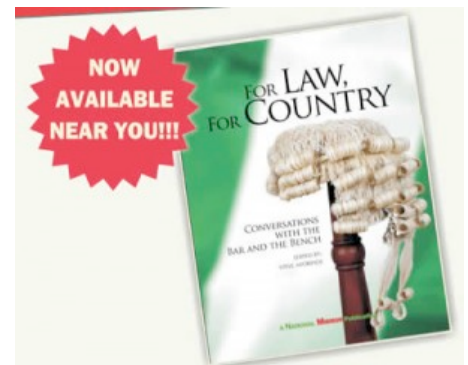


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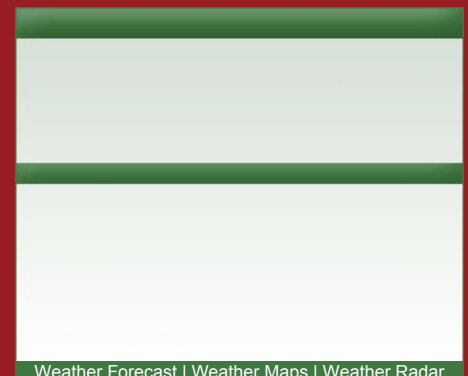
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
