Police arrests ex-Commissioner for alleged murder

The police in Dutse have arrested a man who once served as a commissioner in Jigawa State (names withheld) for an alleged involvement in the killing of two children in Birnin-kudu, Jigawa.

The spokesperson of the police in the state, Abdu Jinjiri, made this known in an interview in Dutse on Thursday.

He said no other arrest had so far been made apart from that of the former commissioner, pointing out that whoever was involved in the killing would be brought to book.

"We are very serious on this case and there will be no sacred cow as whoever is involved will be made to face the law," he said.

The murder of the children linked to the former commissioner made some irate youths to set his house ablaze
