## Envoy loses 6 relations in auto accident

FUNTUA (KATSINA STATE)-Six relatives of Alhaji Abdullahi Aminci, Nigeria's Ambassador to Saudi Arabia have died in an auto accident at Yammama village in Malumfashi Local Government Area, Katsina state.

The Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) Unit Commander in Funtua, Mr. Betara Umar, who confirmed the report said the accident occurred on Saturday night.

He said the deceased were returning to Funtua from a trip to Daura in the state when their Jetta Volkswagen car, with registration number XB 360 FTA, hit a stationary truck registered XA 203 CRC.

A family member, Malam Muhammad Rabi'u, gave the names of the deceased as 90-year-old Alhaji Shehu Nuhu, who was the head of the family, his two wives Hajia Hauwa and Hajia Amina as well as his son, Nuradeen.

The two others who died in the crash were Shehu's granddaughter Amina and a relative Hajia Safiyya Mairuwa.

It was learnt that three people who sustained injuries in the crash were conveyed to Malumfashi General Hospital while the corpses were evacuated to Funtua by relatives for burial.
