It was learnt that the deaths of the **students** of the Institute of Management and Technology Usen is coming on the heels of a protest embarked on by **students** of College of Education, Igueben during which the protesting **students** allegedly seized an A K 47 Riffle of an anti-riot policeman.

It was further learnt that mask-wearing protesting **students** of the Institute of Management and Technology, Usen, had barricaded the Benin-Ore road and made bonfires along the road which resulted in a long vehicular traffic.

A Benin bound ash colored Kia vehicle which registration number could not be ascertained was stopped by the protesting **students**, but the driver of the vehicle in a bid to force his way was said to have ran into some of the **students**, killing **two** and injuring many in the process.

The driver of the vehicle was said to have fled into the bush after the incident and the angry **students** were reported to have damaged the vehicle.

When contacted, Edo State Police Command Public Relation Officer, ASP Peter Ogboi confirmed the **students**' protest but said he was not aware of any accident leading to the death of any student.
