Robbers kill DPO, injure others

Achief superintendent of police, Mr Joseph Ajoge, was killed in Ipetuljesa at 3am on Monday during a gun battle with armed robbers.

Investigations by our correspondent showed that the late police chief led a detachment of policemen on a reinforcement mission to Ipetuljesa, where armed robbers were operating.

It was gathered that Ajoge, who was the Divisional Police Officer, Ipetu-Ijesa police station, headed for the scene of the robbery when he was radioed by a patrol team to send a reinforcement team.

No fewer than five policemen, who went on the reinforcement mission with Ajoge, sustained serious gunshot wounds.
