Four die in auto crash

TWO people were roasted beyond recognition, while two others died from multiple injuries when a car in which they were travelling ran into a pole in the village of Sabon Barki, on the Jos-Bukuru Road in Plateau State.

The accident, which involved a Nissan saloon car with registration No. CE 267 JJN., occurred around 12.30am on Wednesday.

Our correspondent gathered that one of the passengers died instantly while attempting to jump out of the burning vehicle, while the second person died on the way to the hospital.

When our correspondent visited the accident spot around 8am on Wednesday, men of the Federal Road Safety Commission were said to have evacuated the bodies of the two burnt victims and deposited them at the Jos University Teaching Hospital.

The Sector Commander, FRSC, Mr. Wole Olaniran, who confirmed the accidents in an interview with our correspondent in Jos on Wednesday, said that when his men arrived at the the scene, the bodies of two of the victims had been taken to the mortuary by the police.
