## ... another two in Lagos

THE Lagos State Police Command has started investigating the death of two persons in the state.

The two men died while fighting at two separate areas in the state.

The command's Public Relations Officer, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, a deputy superintendent of police, confirmed the cases to our correspondent on Sunday.

Ojajuni said that policemen had visited the scenes and removed the corpses to a mortuary.

He said the State Criminal Investigation Department, Panti Street, Yaba, had taken over investigations into the cases

In the first incident, one Tunde Lawal of Fadeyi Street, Shomolu reportedly engaged one of his neighbours simply identified as Laide in a fight.

Efforts to separate the two feuding parties failed as Laide allegedly hit Lawal on his head with a stick.

The victim was said to have slumped and was thereafter rushed to a nearby hospital for treatment. He died later at the hospital.

The second involved one Kingsley Mbam, a resident of Church Street, Ilaje, Ebute-Metta who engaged Fidelis Nweze in a heated argument.

The disagreement later snowballed into a free-for-all.

During the confrontation, Mbam reportedly gave Nweze a head-butt. The victim died on the spot.
