

Boy's corpse found inside stationary car

POLICEMEN attached to Mushin division in Lagos are now investigating the circumstances surrounding the death of a 10-year-old boy whose corpse was found inside a stationary vehicle on Wednesday.

The remains of the yet-to-be identified boy were found in Council area on Olayide Street in Mushin at about 6.30am when some of the residents were on the way to their places of work.

Our correspondent learnt that the residents subsequently reported the case at the station from where policemen were drafted to the scene to recover the corpse.

A police source said no visible mark of violence was found on the boy's corpse.

Ojajuni, a deputy superintendent of police, confirmed the incident to our correspondent on Thursday.

Ojajuni said the corpse had been deposited at a mortuary for autopsy.

In a related development, a vehicle ran over a two-and-a-half-year old girl on Wednesday in Ajegunle, killing the victim on the spot.

According to a report made at Ajegunle police station, the vehicle marked XH 746 EPE ran over the victim at Iyalode Street.

One Ikechukwu Agana allegedly drove the vehicle.

Ojajuni said the victim's name and address were still unknown.

He warned motorists to be more careful and observe all traffic rules while on the highway.
