

# Community upset over death of security guard

**M**EMBERS of the Ipakodo community in Ikorodu area of Lagos State are still disturbed over the death of a security guard in the area.

The victim, identified as Sunday Ogundele, was attached to a house at Dosunmu Ayodeji Crescent, GRA 2, Alugba Estate, Ipakodo, before his death.

It has not been established how Ogundele was killed or who killed him but our correspondent learnt that police detectives were still interrogating some persons.

Residents of the building discovered the lifeless body of the security man within the compound on Thursday.

However, it is not on record that any form of wound or laceration or sign of strangulation was found on the body.

The incident was reported at the Ipakodo Police Station from where

some policemen were assigned to visit the scene.

Our correspondent learnt that police on-the-spot assessment did not yield any clue on the cause of death.

The corpse was later removed from the house and deposited at the state mortuary for autopsy.

It was learnt that the police had not got a clue to the cause of death despite the interrogation of some persons.

Spokesman for the Lagos State Police Command, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, a deputy superintendent of police, confirmed the incident to our correspondent on Monday.

Ojajuni stated that the police would not like to rush into conclusion on the cause of death, adding that the result of the autopsy would be helpful in their investigation.

He said the case had been referred to the State Criminal Investigation Department, Panti, Yaba, for further action.
