Militants kill two soldiers, kidnap three oil workers in Bayelsa

Come Niger Delta Omilitants, on Thursday night, took over the Nun River Flow Station of the Shell Petroleum Develop-Company ment Oporoma, headquarters of Southern liaw Local Government Area of Bayelsa State.

Three soldiers were feared killed, while three oil workers were held hostage.

The identities of the slain

Bisi Olaniyi, Yenagoa soldiers and the kidnapped staff of the Anglo/Dutch oil

giant could not be ascertained as at press-time. The incident occurred barely a week after militants invaded the terminal of the Nigerian Agip Oil Company at Twon-Brass, headquarters of Brass Local Government Area of Bayelsa State, with four expatriates

still being held hostage at

an unknown location in the Niger Delta.

One of the Twon-Brass vouth who attempted to rescue the three Italians and a Lebanese working for Agip, was gunned down. Others sustained varying
