

# Murder suspect dies in police custody

ONE of the seven murder suspects facing prosecution over the murder of a chief-tain of the Peoples Democratic Party, Chief Tony Osanyin, Dayo Anjorin, is dead.

Anjorin, a tertiary institution student, who was arrested on January 29, 2007, along with six others, died in the custody of the special anti-robbery division in Oke-Baale, Osogbo, last week.

Commissioner of Police, Osun State Command, Mr. Sulaimon Fakai, confirmed the incident to our correspondent in a telephone interview on Sunday.

It was gathered that the corpse of the suspect was yet to be released to his family for burial.

Osanyin was killed in his residence at No 1, Tony Osanyin on December 20, 2006 when the suspects came to rob members of his household.

The politician's double-barrelled gun; mobile telephones and N70,000 belonging to his wife were carted away by the hoodlums.

Parading the suspects, last week, a Deputy Commis-

sioner of Police, Mr. David Omojola, said one locally-made pistol and 20 cartridges were recovered from the them.

Omojola, who said investigations were still in progress, maintained that the command would bring all persons found culpable in the killing to justice.
