

Youth killed in cult clash

A young man in his twenties was on Sunday, February 18, 2007 killed in a cult clash in Port Harcourt, the Rivers State capital.

A rival cult group had caused a commotion at Amadi Roundabout as its members, armed to the teeth, organised themselves to embark on a revenge mission, apparently following the death of the youth, presumed to be a member.

As the cult members filed on a road leading to the roundabout, commuters and pedestrians began to run for their lives.

It was in the mad rush to escape that the corpse of the youth, earlier killed by another cult group, was found on the road.

Amadi Abuloma Road has been noted for all manner of violence.

However, the names of the cult groups could not be ascertained. The institution they came from could not be ascertained either.
