The bandits numbering about 15 went to the station around 2am and started shooting at the duty offic-

ers, who were caught unawares by the sudden attack. During the exchange of gunfire, Inspector Raymond Mamman and Sergeant Patrick Eze were killed, while two robbers were gunned down, and a third sustained gun wounds.
