According to him, "the driver of the car was trying to avoid a pothole when he lost control and collided with the station-

ary trailer. The driver and

his wife died on the spot."

He disclosed that their corpse had been deposited at the mortuary of the Mokwa General Hospital, while the injured soldiers were receiving treatment in the same hospital.

Adeshina stated the need for both motorists and the members of the public to always be safety conscious always.

It will be recalled that four persons died and 12 others were injured last week in an auto crash along the same road.
