

Boyfriend kills lover in her father's bedroom

The police in Lagos have commenced investigation into the circumstances surrounding the murder of a lady, Miss Stella Bob-Manuel, by her boyfriend, simply identified as Odafe.

The incident, which had been reported at the State Criminal Investigation Department in Panti Street, Yaba, by the family of the deceased, occurred around 1pm on Monday.

According to the police report obtained on Tuesday, Odafe went to his girlfriend's house on No 8, Adewuyi Street in the Ijeshatedo area of the state and engaged in a heated argument with Stella.

The development degenerated into a bloody situation and the lover-boy, reached out for a knife, chased the girl into her father's bedroom and stabbed her many times in different parts of her body.

The man, obviously aware of the criminal implication of his act, later took the same knife and stabbed himself.

The two lovers were rushed to an unnamed hospital where the doctors managed to save the life of the lover-boy but his girlfriend was not lucky. She was confirmed dead moments after.

Detectives from the CID had visited the scene of the incident and had ordered the transfer of the corpse from the hospital to a government mortuary for autopsy.

The Public Relations Officer of the state police command, Mr. Olubode Ojajuni, confirmed the incident and said full investigation on it had begun.

Meanwhile, three persons including a lady were reported dead while riding on commercial motorcycles in two different areas of Lagos on Monday.

While the lady, Igu Odili, fell from a moving motorcycle on the Ejigbo-Isolo Road and died instantly, two passengers were killed around 11.50pm when the motorcycle they were riding on collided with a trailer on LASU-Igando Road.
