Violence: Four killed, houses destroyed in Edo

The police in Edo State have deployed several detachment of its men in Akoko-Edo where violence erupted a few days ago.

The incident was said to have caused the death of four persons and the destruction of several houses.

The deployment of the security operatives came just as the Edo State House of Assembly condemned the development.

The violence was said to have been ignited by a dispute between two neighbouring communities in the area.

The Assembly had through a resolution asked the police to stop the violence and bring the situation under control.

The member representing Akoko-Edo (1), Mr. Anselm Agbabi, had brought on the floor of the House a matter of urgent public importance that bordered on the lives of his people.
