Three policemen die in Oyo during shoot-out with robbers

THREE policemen who were injured during a shoot-out with armed robbers in Oyo town on Wednesday have died.

Subsequently, the Divisional Police Officer at the Ojongbodu Police Division, where the incident took place, had been recalled by the Commissioner of Police in charge of the command, Mr. Udom Ekpoudom.

Police sources said his recall may not be unconnected with his alleged lackadaisical attitude to the robbery attack witnessed in Oyo township on Wednesday.

Sources said the robbers invaded Oyo town in three Hilux Pick-up vans, with Federal Government number plates, while Catholic Diocese of Oyo was inscribed on the

sides of the vehicles.

They had successfully robbed a bank within Ojongbodu Division before they moved to another bank in the town.
