

PDP chief dies in auto accident

FOUR days after two former legislators of the Osun State Peoples Democratic Party died in separate incidents, the party, again lost its state Deputy Chairman, Chief Lawrence Agbola.

Agbola died on Saturday at the Osun State Hospital, Osogbo following an auto accident on the Ibokun-Ilare road.

He was the elder brother to the late Military Secretary, Nigerian Army, Maj-Gen. Olutayo Agbola, who died in a plane crash alongside seven other officers en route the Obudu Cattle Ranch on September 17, 2006.

One of the medical officials that treated Agbola expressed shock at his sudden death after he had stabilised.

The official, who asked not to be named, said Agbola was slightly injured in the jaw, which was stitched.

He added that when he complained of pelvic pain, an x-ray conducted showed no sign of a broken bone.

The Osun Deputy Governor, Mrs. Olusola Obada, was in shock when she saw the corpse of the party leader in the hospital.
