Uzor said an accident had occurred near the spot 30 minutes earlier, where a 911 truck pushed a Toyota Hiace bus into the ditch. But no life was lost in that accident.

It was indeed the first accident that caused the traffic iam on the slope when the descending kerosene tanker ran into the Toyota bus. The FRSC commander lamented the slow pace of work on the other lane of the dualcarriageway by RCC, which had been at the spot in the last three months. He appealed to the Federal

Ministry of Transportation and the Edo State Government to bring pressure to bear on the contractor handling the repair of the failed section of the road to expedite action on the rehabilitation of the road.
