

Two die on Benin-Ore Road

A man and his driver died on Tuesday on Benin-Ore Expressway in an auto crash while bringing a new truck they had bought in Cotonou, Benin Republic, to Benin.

The Benin Toll Gate Unit Commander of the Federal Road Safety Commission, Mr. Chukwuma Uzor, who led the rescue operation at the accident scene, told our correspondent that the Man Diesel truck they were travelling in ran into the Ovia River slope valley after its brakes failed.

He said the owner and the driver had a stop over at Ota, Ogun State, where they picked a third person.

Uzor, who gave the number of the vehicle as XA 932 KMK, said the third person survived with injuries.
