After the man had finished his 'assignment,' he allegedly refused to pay the lady the exact amount bargained for.

The lady, who was operating in a brothel along the railway line, Oto bus stop, also insisted on collecting her money from the man.

A fight broke out and during the scuffle, the customer reportedly used a broken bottle to stab Blessing.

The victim bled to death while the culprit immediately fled after which the case was reported to the police at Denton Street, Ebute Meta.

Although the police said they had arrested three suspects in connection with the incident, the killer is still on the run.

Similarly, a man identified as Harrison, was stabbed to death by one of his co-tenants after his wife had a disagreement with the suspected killer.

Both men were residents of Kehinde Street, Gbagada, Lagos, and it was learnt that Harrison's wife had a quarrel with one Michael Ekpenyong.
