Police arrest four youths for murder

The spokesman of the command, Mr Ibokette Iniobong, told the News Agency of Nigeria on Thursday in Yenagoa that the incident occurred on September 11, 2008. He said the police received a report from Chief Gospel Kpokpowei, a businessman and owner of the filling station that some youths, led by one Elekume Daniel, had attacked his workers at the site.

Iniobong said Kpokpowei told the police that his site manager, Azuka Diokpala, called to inform him that some youths attacked workers at the site with machetes and clubs. He said the youths beat the workers to a state of coma after which one of them, who was rushed to the Federal Medical Centre, Yenagoa died.
