Tenant charged for murdering landlord

28-year-old civil servant, Bright Nwagiriga, was on Monday remanded in prison custody for the alleged murder of his landlord

Nwagiriga, a tenant at 4.

Aina Street, Ijeshatedo, Lagos,

appeared before a Yaba Magistrate's Court for stabbing his landlord, Mr. Noble Ikpi over a misunderstanding.

The News Agency of Nigeria also reported that the police prosecutor, Mr. Benson Emuerhi, told the court that trouble started when Nwagiriga was accused by his landlord of being a member of a gang that

robbed the next compound.

According to him, the accused became furious, a situation that led to a fight during which he got hold of a knife and allegedly stabbed the landlord to death.

Emuerhi said the accused
