

Gunmen kill don's driver

THE CLEEN Foundation says it will in collaboration with the Lagos State Security Trust Fund, commence the second Lagos crime victimisation and safety survey on Wednesday (today).

A statement by Mr. Innocent Chukwuma and Mr. Fola Arthur-Worrey, in Lagos on Tuesday, said the three-week survey was expected to cover all the local government

Quarters, Ijebu Ode in Ogun State.

The deceased, who was in his late 30's, was said to be the driver of the Dean, Students Affairs, Tai Solarin University of Education, Ijagun, Ijebu Ode.

Our correspondent gathered that his murder might not be unconnected with some transaction he had with some students of the university.

He was said to have promised to use his close relationship with the dean to help some students settle their problems in the department for a fee.

Alatishe was alleged to have been engaging in the deal for over a year.

A source disclosed that

some students confronted him in August 2008 for allegedly collecting money from them without solving their problems as promised.

The source said that he was beaten to a coma before he was released.

But he was not that lucky on Monday.

His assailants reportedly arrived at his house in a car and ordered him to open the door.

They allegedly shot him at a close range after challenging him "for not settling them."

When contacted, the Ijebu Police Area Commander, Mr. Oyedokun Omolodun, confirmed the incident.

Omolodun said that Obalende Police Station was investigating the matter.
