

Police probe woman's death in cassava farm

THE police in Anambra State said on Thursday that they were investigating the death of a 65-year-old woman found dead in her cassava farm at Ezicama village, Uli in Ihiala Local Government Area.

The deceased, Mrs. Cecilia Obi, was found dead with a machete cut in the head.

The Divisional Police Officer in charge of Uli, Mr. Ebok Archibong, confirmed the incident to reporters.

Archibong said the remains of the deceased

were deposited at the Lady of Lourdes' Mortuary, Ihiala.

He said though investigations were on to fish out the killers, no arrests had been made yet.

Cecilia's husband, George, had reported the matter to the police.
