Police detain five NSCDC men over man's death

THE Ogun State Police Command has detained five officials of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defence Corps over the death of one Alade Ijiola during a disagreement over sand excavation.

The police arrested two intelligence officers and three other personnel with the NSCDC who were suspected to have beat the deceased to death.

The five officials of the NSCDC in police detention over the killing of the man since last Monday are two intelligence officers and three others.

The Ogun State commandant of the NSCDC, Mr. Bamidele Popoola, in an interview with journalists in Abeokuta, on Thursday, however, denied that the men of the NSCDC beat Ijiola to death.
