



Police corporal kills senator's driver

A police corporal on Saturday evening shot and killed one of the drivers of Senator Nuhu Aliyu, identified as Malam Ahmed Namaikoko.

The *News Agency of Nigeria* on Monday quoted police authorities as saying that the incident occurred when the driver was taking some policemen to a robbery scene along the Minna-Tegina Road in Niger State.

The state police command's Public Relations Officer, Mr. Richard Oguche, confirmed the incident to NAN in Minna on Monday.

He said that the incident occurred while the driver was assisting the police to convey some policemen to the robbery spot.

"A traditional ruler had reported to the Yakila Police Station that some robbers

had attempted to rob him when he was returning to the village.

"This prompted the officers to seek assistance to mobilise their men to the spot.

"The driver, who is working with one of our retired senior personnel (Senator Nuhu Aliyu), volunteered to convey our officers to the robbery spot and a corporal accidentally shot and killed the driver on their way," he said.

He said the corporal had been arrested and detained, adding, "He will be tried administratively before any legal action is taken against him by the force."

Oguche said the police had released the corpse of the driver to his family for burial.
